Chapter 5

The Challenges Ahead

The Barack Obama story to date remains an unfinished tale. In some ways, Obama seems to be more famous for what he might yet do rather than for what he has actually done. Indeed, despite his many accomplishments thus far, many people believe that his greatest successes are still to come. Therefore, he has become the subject of a great deal of speculation as a politician with unlimited potential, a future leader who could unite numerous contentious factions and bring real change and progress to government, the country, and the world.

Of course, it will be hard to live up to such expectations. His future as a leader is by no means assured. For example, some of his strengths—his heritage, his beliefs, his voting record—could also be construed as political weaknesses that potential opponents will likely exploit. However, time and time again Obama has seemed to say and do the right thing at the right time at each stage of his life. And though people may argue about the future of his career, there is one point on which everyone can agree—Obama is someone worth watching on the American political scene.

Bridging Divides

One of the most repeated compliments made about Obama is that he is able to bring opposing groups together. In Washington,

this is known as working both sides of the political aisle, which means that he is capable of collaborating with certain Republican counterparts to win important votes for proposed legislation. This is critically important when a bill founders in committee because Democrats and Republicans cannot agree on an issue. Too often senators are derided for being partisan, voting according to the dictates of their political party rather than on their core personal beliefs or on what is best for the public.

Such partisanship and the overall bureaucracy of government have caused people to lose faith in Washington, says Obama. He explains in his book, *The Audacity of Hope*:

They [Americans] may still vote, out of habit, anger, or some atavistic sense of civic obligation. But they don't have much confidence that government can do them a lot of good. They

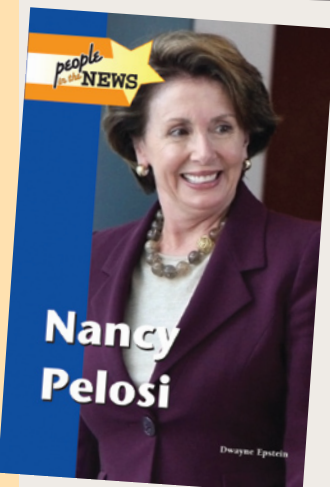
